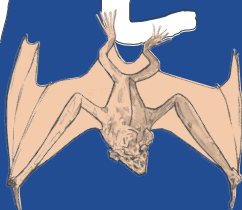

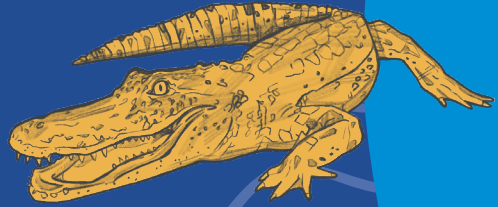
# CHILDREN'S SCULPTURE TRAIL
